

Using VerseVIEW 1/3rd view with OBS to layer Lyrics and Bible verses on Video



Setting VerseVIEW

1. Launch VerseVIEW
2. Go to Screens Tab
3. Enable Stage Presentation
4. Uncheck "Keep Presentation Window on Top" selection and click SAVE

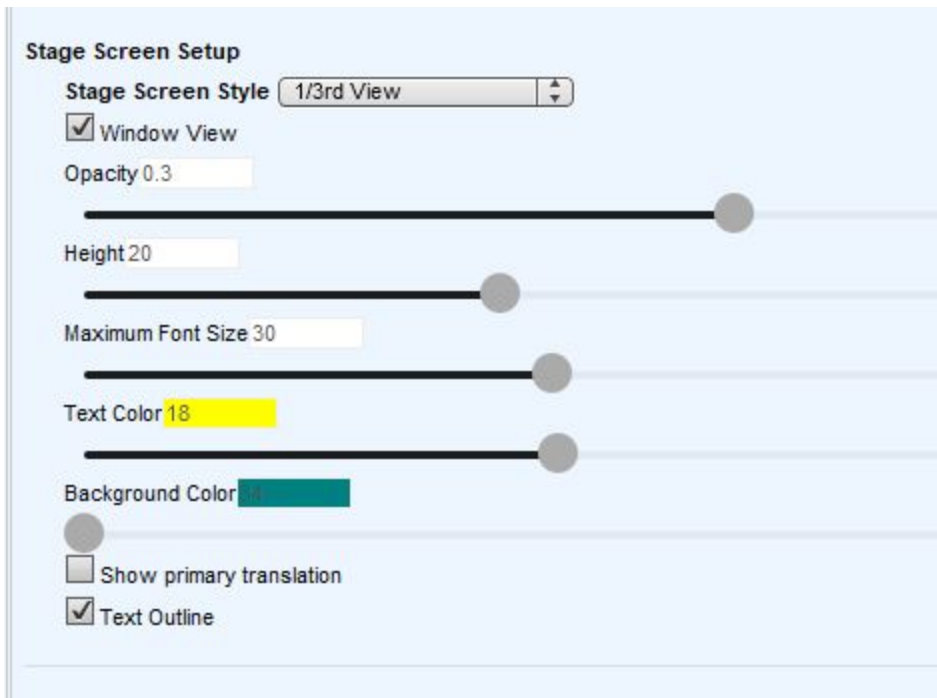

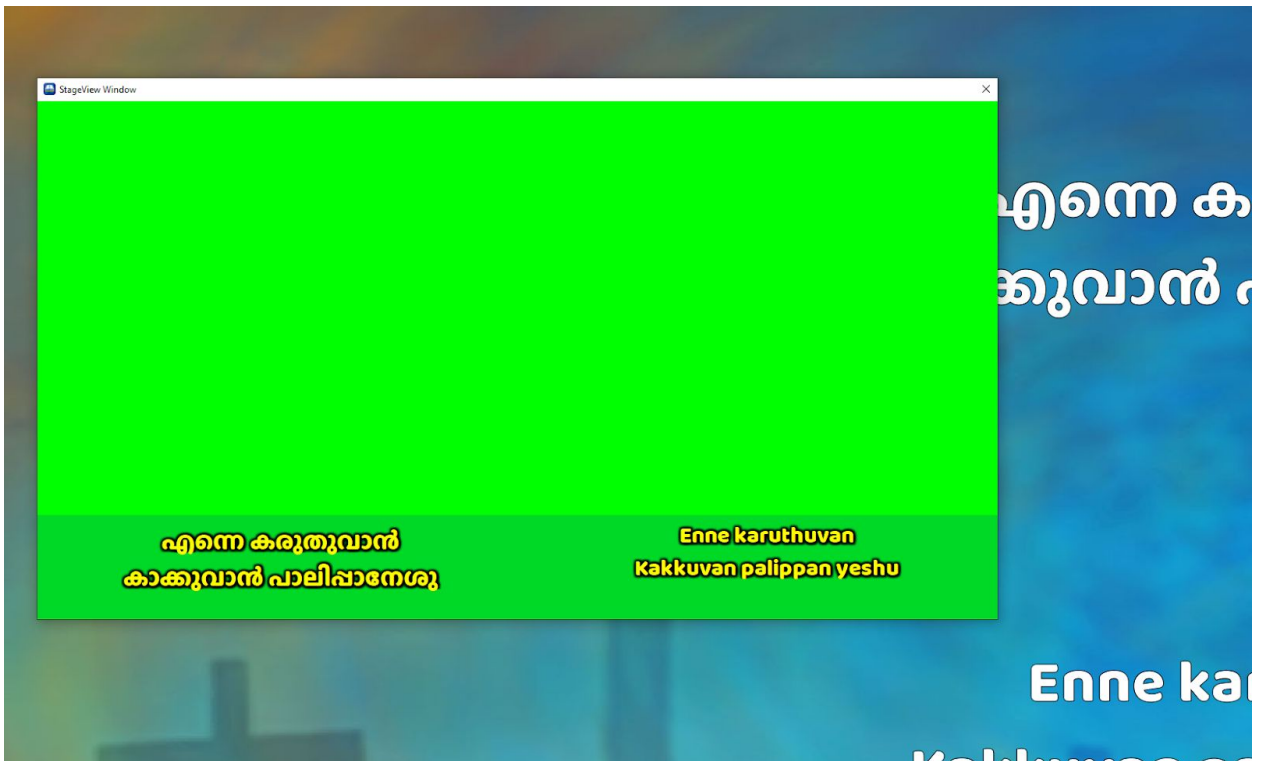

5. Scroll down to Stage Screen Setup

6. Select 1/3rd View for Style
7. Check the box for Window View
8. Set other configurations according to your choice

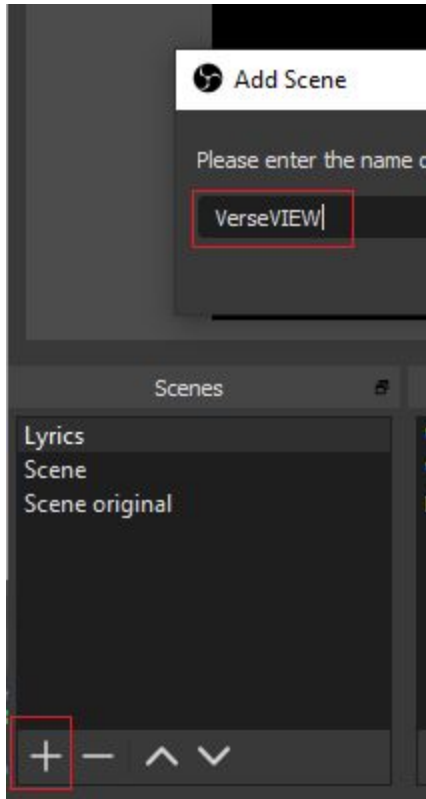


9. Select a song or Bible verse and click it. It will open the presentation and another window for 1/3rd view with green background (for chroma key)

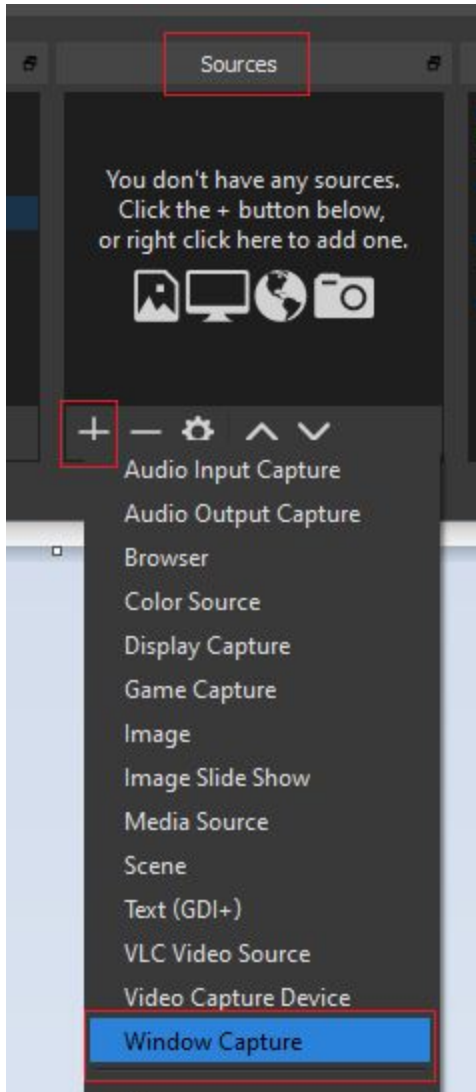


Setting OBS

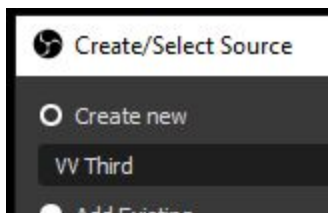
1. Open OBS
2. Click on the + under scenes to create a new scene. Give any name for your scene.



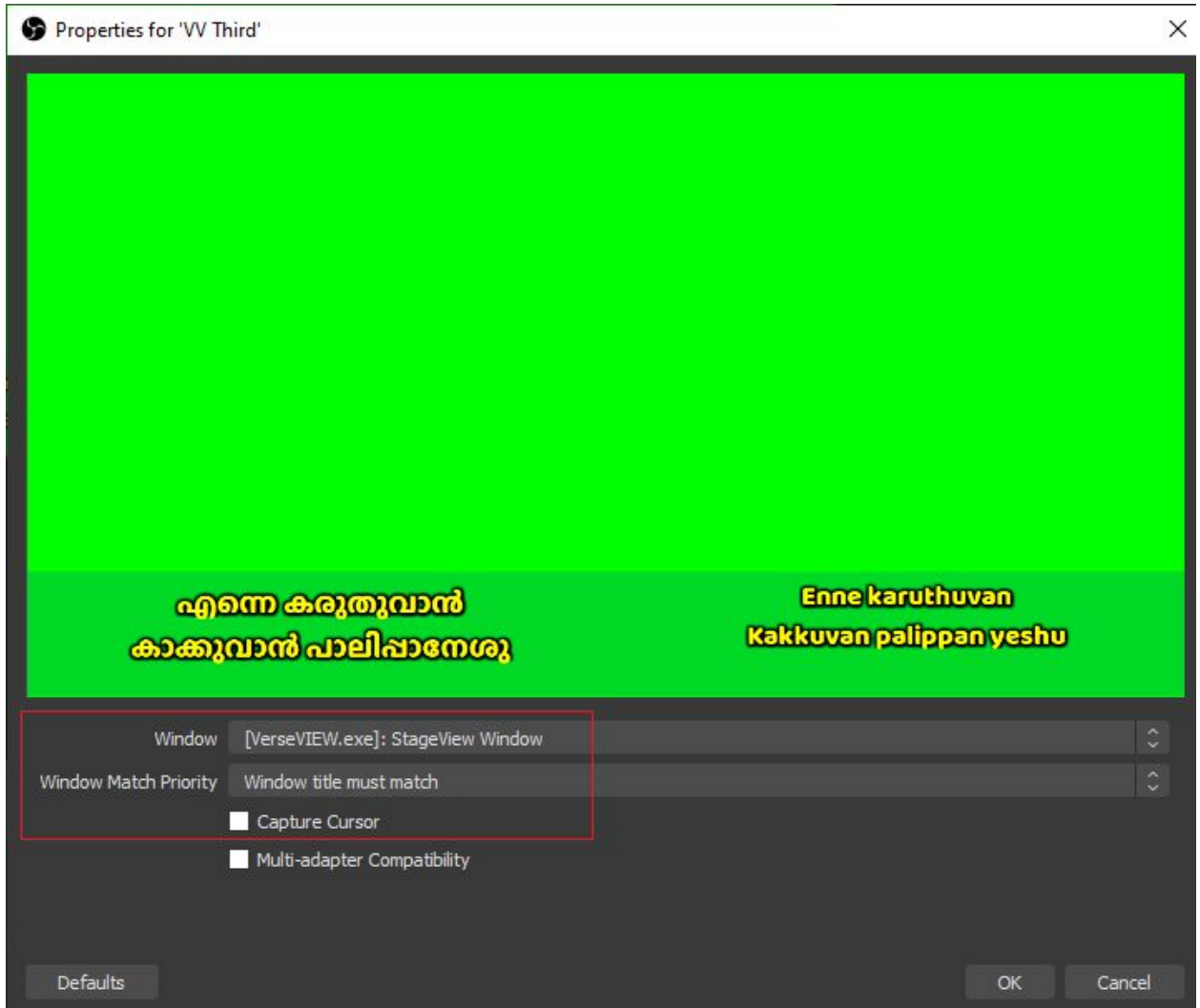
3. In the Source section, click on the + symbol and add new source and select Window Capture.



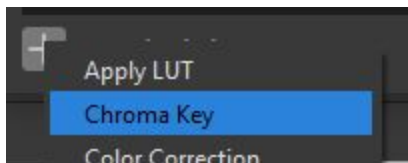
4. Provide a name for the Source. For example VV Third



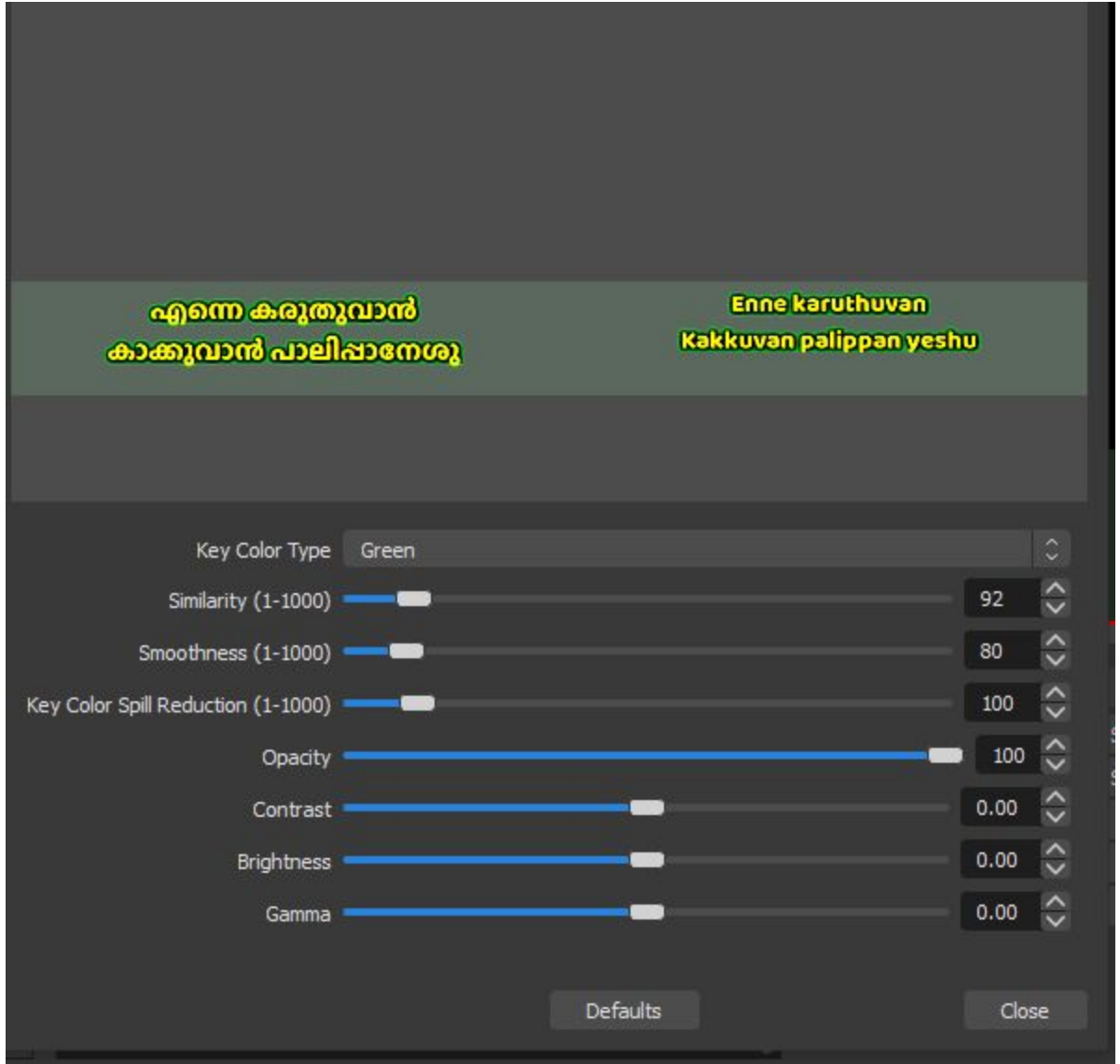
5. Select Window that says [VerseVIEW.exe]: StageView Window
6. Select "Window Title must match" option for Match priority
7. Uncheck the Capture Cursor box



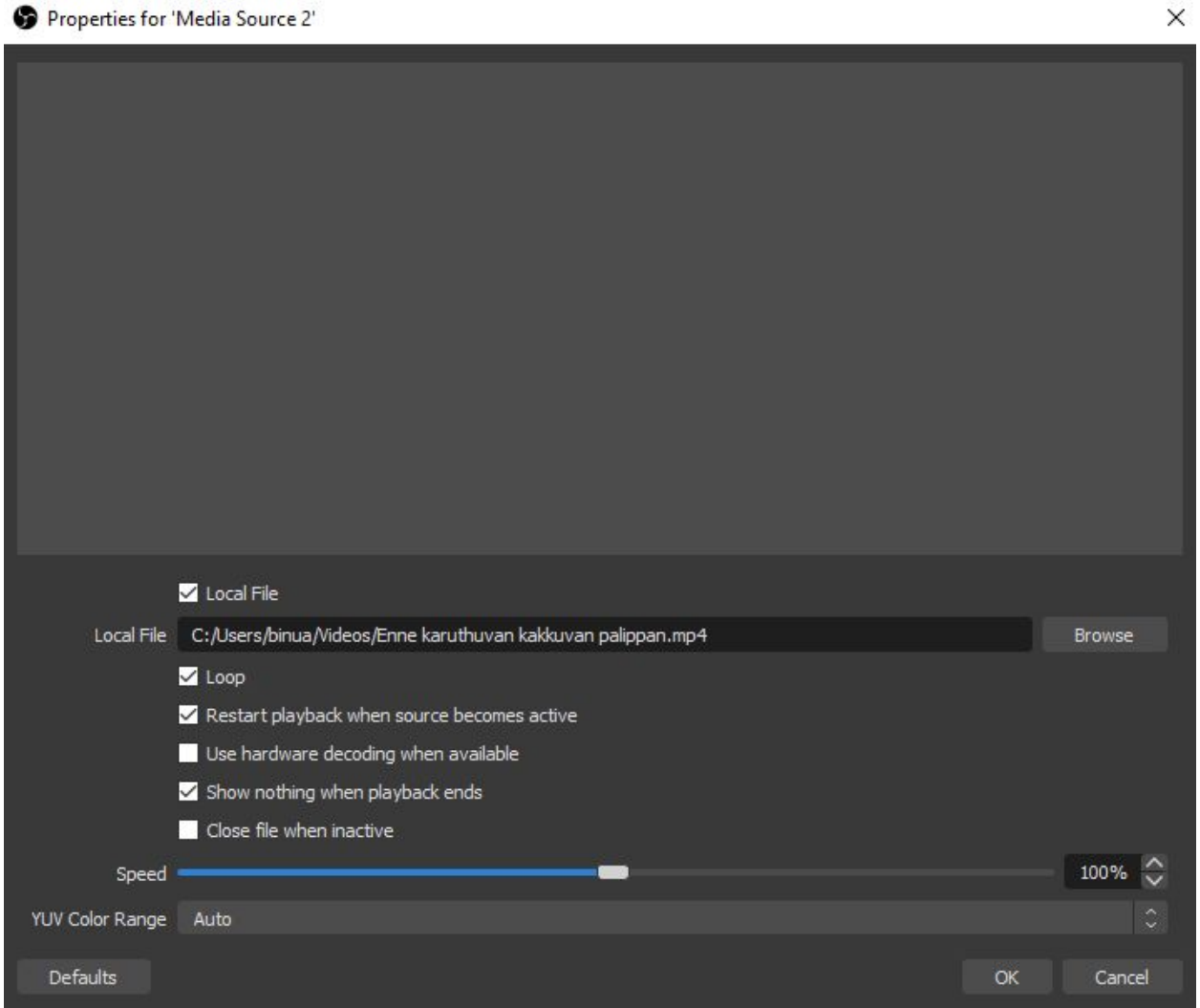
8. Resize the Window as needed.
9. Right click on VV Third selection and select Filters
10. Click on the + symbol and select Chroma Key



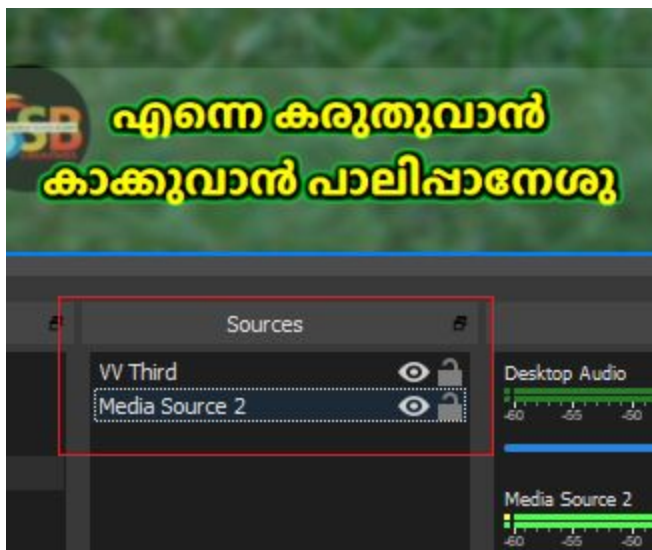
11. Select the following settings to remove the Green background.
12. Adjust the Similarity setting to get the best contrast



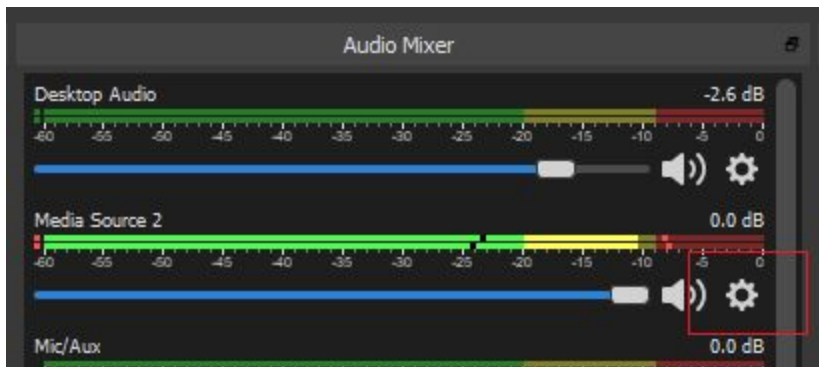
13. No to add the video, click on the + symbol in the Sources and select Media Source and give a name
14. Select the video file and check the box for Loop



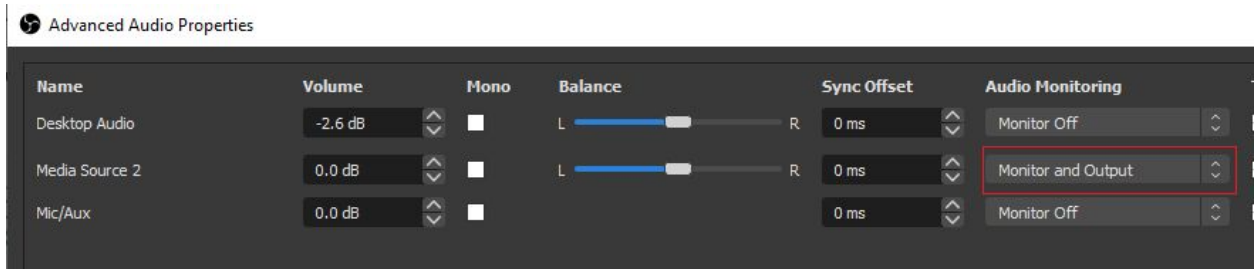
15. Rearrange the source so VV Third is on the top.



16. To enable sound, click on the settings button for Media Source and select Advanced Audio properties.



17. Change the Audio Monitoring to Monitor and Output



18. At this stage, we can click on Start Recording to capture the video with lyrics saved to a file or streaming.

If capturing from YouTube video, run the YouTube video on full screen on the secondary monitor.
